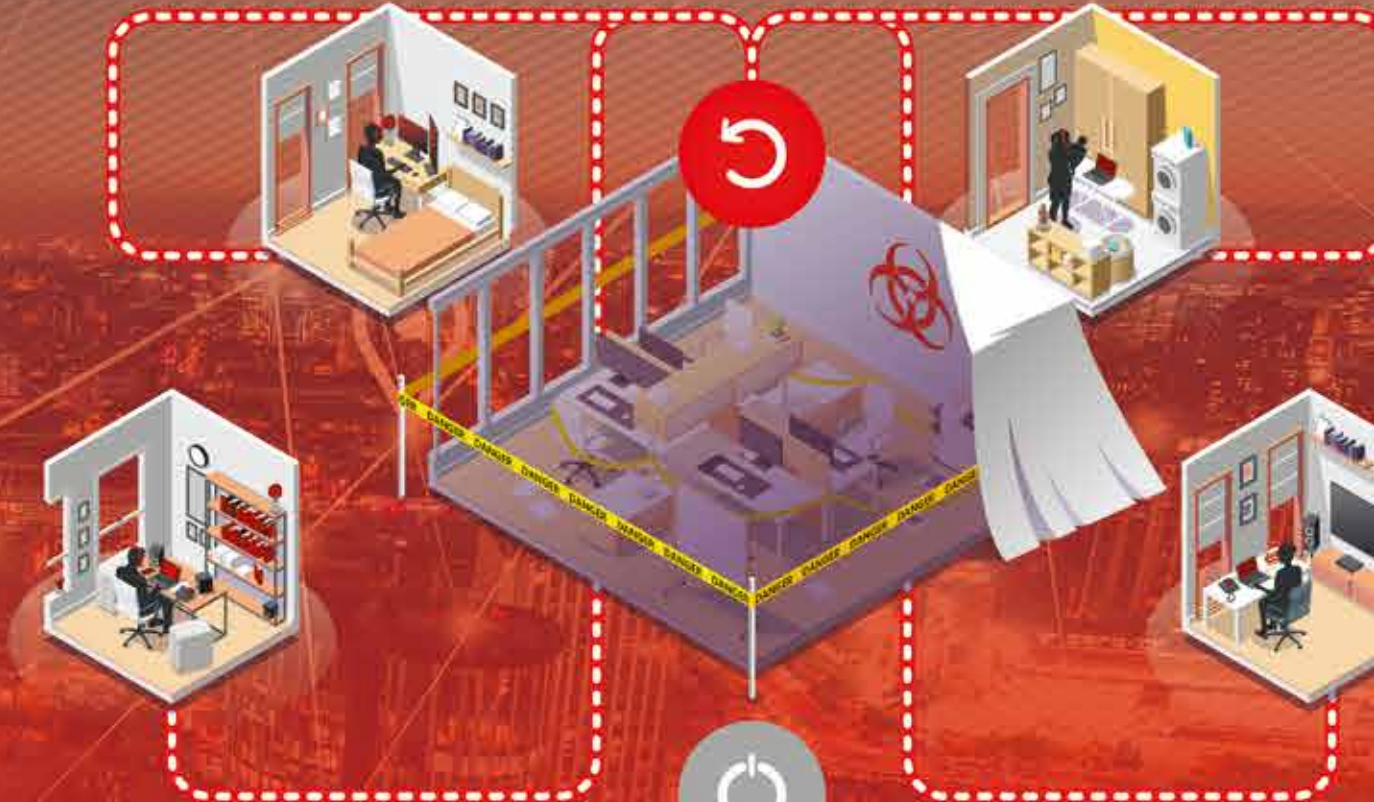

The Journey to Digital

Traditional Business

Hybrid Business

A business embracing the best of digital and integrating it to traditional business models and structures.

- Some physical space, but focus on meeting rooms and collaboration spaces
- Significant percentage of workforce work remotely, workforce rotates from physical to digital
- Significant number of meetings transition to virtual
- Migration to the cloud, but also the use of physical data servers
- Increased use of collaboration software and productivity tools
- HQ enabled with fixed line connectivity while workforce is digitally driven
- Big Data, AI, Analytics for Business more prevalent due to cloud services adopted
- Security challenges to new remote workforce

Digital Business
