Contention Ratio

All upstream and backbone Internet infrastructure is shared. With consumer-grade internet, there's a larger number of people sharing the same infrastructure, which means performance can be impacted. Business Internet keeps congestion lower, so your business speeds stay more consistent, even during those busy times.

Symmetrical Access

Consumer-grade internet is fast for downloads but slow if you're uploading or sending files (and that's the reason the up and download speeds noted on consumer lines are different from each other). If you regularly upload content, select a Business Internet plan that offers symmetrical speeds (it's not available across all plans).

Static IP Address

Business Internet offers a static IP address on select plans. This is essential for teams who need to connect remotely, as a fixed IP ensures the access URL stays the same every time. It's also crucial for running services like CCTV, which rely on a consistent connection point. In contrast, most consumer packages come with a dynamic IP address that changes regularly, making remote access less reliable.



Business Internet Fibre


